

#### **ANNUAL PLAN - 2019-20**

- 1. <u>Short Title:</u> This constitutes the "Annual plan" for short term and long term projects as envisaged under \$.14 of 'The Tamil Nadu District Mineral Foundation Rules, 2017' published in the Gazette as per the G.O. Ms. No. 57, Industries (MMD.1) 19th May 2017.
- **2. <u>Definitions:</u>** In this plan, the definitions are as enlisted in S.2 of the said rules. In addition the following terms are defined herein:-
  - (a) "Short term project" means those projects that are totally executed within a year or that the benefits accruing out of them are wholly realizable within the financial year of execution.
- **(b)**"Long term project" means those projects, the implementation of which or the accrual of benefits arising from it spans multiple financial year.

#### 3. Aims and Objectives:-

The principle aims and objectives of this plan are:-

- (a) To create a plan to utilize the funds vested with the District Mineral foundation for the welfare of the people directly and indirectly affected by mining activities; and the welfare of the mining affected area by implementing projects as mentioned in S.13 of the Rules.
- **(b)** To allocate the scarce budget in an equitable and rational manner across all sectors of development and geographical areas to both long term and short term projects in such manner as to extract optimal social output.

#### 4. Guidance:-

The Guidance in selecting the individual projects both in the short term plan and the long term plan as per guidelines enumerated in S.13. The following major sectors have been identified to take works in the annual action plan.

#### A. Welfare of mine affected People

- a) Education
- b) Skill Development
- c) Drinking water Supply
- d) Health care

#### B. Welfare of mine affected area

- a) Environmental Conservation and pollution control measures
- b) Disaster management and mitigation

#### 5. Methodology:-

The following methodology has been adopted to select works under District Mineral Foundation trust.

- a) As per the decision taken in the Governing council meeting held on-21.02.2018 the request to propose works under district mineral foundation trust was sent to all nodal departments.
- b) List of mining affected villages was circulated to the nodal departments who were asked to send proposal for welfare of mining affected people and mining affected areas.
- c) The mandatory share of allocation, not less than 60%, for the welfare of mining affected people was strictly followed.
- d) The priority was given to the works for which hold allocated from state or central governments in any other schemes.
- e) The annual action plan has been prepared for the amount which has been collected, arrears to be collected and the projected inflow of funds in the financial year 2018-19.
- f) The plan was divided into two parts as 'Short Term Plan' which is to be executed in one financial year. 'Long term plan' which will require to execute more than one year to execute.

### 6. Short term plan (Welfare of mining affected people) a) Education

Construction of school buildings, Additional class rooms, Laboratories, Libraries, Art and crafts room, Toilet blocks, Drinking water, provisions Residential Hostels for students/teachers in remote areas, sports infrastructure etc.
